SELLING MERINO LAMBS AS PRIME LAMBS

Selling wether lambs as prime lambs is a big part of what we do and as the markets have risen dramatically in the past year we been able to capitalise on these markets with that are fit for purpose for lamb buyers.

Our lambs regularly dress out in 24 to 28 kg range which at today's meat values and combined with a very strong wool market make them a very lucrative outfit.

WOOL

Our ewes are cutting on average 7kgs of 18.5 micron wool which at today's wool market values is equal to about \$110 per head before shearing costs.

When all this is combined with surplus sheep sales, a self replacing Merino flock with a focus on exceptional carcass traits and wools, it becomes a very profitable enterprise. Big wool cuts, low microns quality wool and lambs with shape and carcass are attractive in any market.

Exceptional carcass traits, high-value wool, and a self-replacing flock model mean guaranteed resilience, no matter where the market goes.
